unfettered airing of political views of their choice on broadcast media or the Internet.

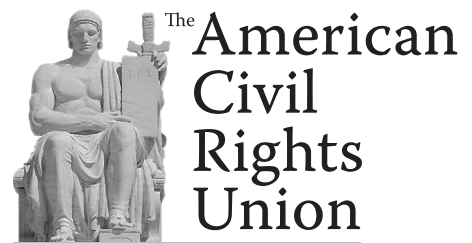
